

Mr Vice-President,

New Zealand **welcome's** Nigeria's efforts to support human rights since its last UPR.

New Zealand recommends that Nigeria:

- Repeal legislation that discriminates against LGBTQI+ individuals and same-sex marriage, including relevant sections in the Criminal Code Act 1990 and the Same-Sex Marriage (Prohibition) Act 2013;
- 2. Pass the Gender and Equal Opportunities bill into law; and
- Continue to work on fully implementing the Violence against Persons (Prohibition) Act 2015 across all states, to further support the elimination of violence against women and girls.
