Retrospective Overseas Travel: Hon Rino Tirikatene

1. Following the Prime Minister's in-principle approval for me to travel to Singapore 6 – 10 June 2023, I am seeking Cabinet's retrospective approval.

Reasons for Travel

- 2. The purpose of the travel is to advance New Zealand's trade and export growth interests in areas including supply chain resilience, digital economy and green economy initiatives with my Singaporean government counterparts.
- 3. I will also engage with my Singaporean government counterparts on our regional partnership on the ASEAN Australia New Zealand Free Trade Agreement (AANZFTA) and the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP). This will include discussion on the upcoming AANZFTA Upgrade.
- 4. This includes meeting with the Minister of State for Trade and Industry, Mr Alvin Tan,

 . This is an excellent opportunity
 to further enhance the deep connections New Zealand has with Minister Tan^{s6(a)}
- 5. s6(b)(i)
- 6. I will also lead a Māori Aquaculture (Land-Based) Investment Feasibility Tour, and speak at an NZTE InvestHer pitch evening with Singapore investors. The Tour will include a trade and investment Māori delegation of 5-10 senior level delegates, which will explore land-based aquaculture technology and drive greenfield investment in the aquaculture sector across New Zealand.
- 7. The delegation will meet with various Singaporean entities, including representatives from Apollo Aquaculture Group; Cube2; Sembcorp Industries; Agency for Science, Technology and Research; Public Utilities Board and Facilities; and Temasek Life Sciences Laboratory.
- 8. Overall, my visit will also support relationship building between key Māori exporters, iwi and Singapore government agencies, technology entities, and investors to unlock commercial and technology transfer opportunities. This is well-aligned with objectives promoting Māori businesses under the Trade for All and Aotearoa ki te Ao strategies, creating trade and export lift for New Zealand.
- 9. This travel also aligns with both the Trade for All agenda and the Trade Recovery Strategy and supports sustainable and inclusive economic development in sectors where there is potential for long-term growth.

10. I depart New Zealand by commercial means today, Tuesday 6 June, and return to New Zealand by commercial means on the morning of 10 June.

11. I will be accompanied by one staff member from my office and one official from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade. The costs have been met by the agency.
