The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (the Ministry) intends to proactively release the text of the NZ-UAE CEPA Foreign Trade Agreement (FTA) after the agreement has been signed. We anticipate this signing will be in early 2025. Once published the text will be available on the Ministry's website via the below link:

Until the agreement is signed this text is withheld in full under the below sections of the OIA:

- 6(e)(vi) to avoid damage to the New Zealand economy by the premature disclosure of decisions relating to entering into overseas trade agreements; and
- 9(2)(f)(iv): to protect the confidentiality of advice tendered by Ministers of the Crown and officials.

Where the information has been withheld under section 9 of the OIA, we have identified no public interest in releasing the information that would override the reasons for withholding it.
