On 8 July 2024, Cabinet:

- authorised the absence of Rt Hon Winston Peters from New Zealand, from 14 to 20 July 1 2024, to travel to Seoul, Republic of Korea and Tokyo, Japan to attend the 10th triennial Japan Pacific Island Leaders Meeting and to undertake bilateral programmes;
- agreed that he be accompanied by one staff member; 2
- 3 approved the estimated expenditure of up to \$58,246 for the travel expenses of the ministerial party, as a charge to Vote Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive – Travel);
- noted that he will also be accompanied by officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and 4 Trade, whose travel costs will be met by the Ministry;
- 5 agreed that in his absence:
 - Hon Judith Collins KC act as Minister of Foreign Affairs; 5.1
 - Hon Judith Collins KC act as Minister for Racing on 14 July 2024; 5.2
 - 5.3 Hon Andrew Bayly act as Minister for Racing from 15 to 20 July 2024;
- noted that the House is not sitting during his absence. 6

Proposed Overseas Travel: Rt Hon Winston Peters - July 2024

- I seek Cabinet approval to travel to Japan and the Republic of Korea from Sunday 14 July to Saturday 20 July to attend the 10th triennial Japan Pacific Island Leaders Meeting (PALM10) and to undertake bilateral programmes in Tokyo and Seoul.
- 2 The Prime Minister's Office has approved this travel in-principle.

Purpose of Travel

- With Japan a Pacific Islands Forum Dialogue Partner, Ministerial engagement at PALM 10 is an important opportunity to advance our Pacific priorities. It also presents an opportunity to highlight New Zealand Japan cooperation in the Pacific.
- The visit to Japan will build on the Prime Minister's recent visit and further strengthen the New Zealand Japan bilateral relationship. The programme in Tokyo will include a range of meetings with Japanese counterparts to emphasise New Zealand's strong strategic alignment with Japan and reinforce our desire to do more together.
- The visit to the Republic of Korea will strengthen the New Zealand Korea bilateral relationship. During the visit, we will connect with Korean counterparts, to reinforce New Zealand's commitment to maintaining peace on the Korean Peninsula, and to emphasise our strong strategic alignment with Korea.

Outline of Proposed Visit

- 6 At PALM10, we intend to:
 - Hold bilateral meetings with Pacific leaders in attendance;
 - Represent New Zealand at the PALM10 Summit meetings and working lunch; and
 - Attend a banquet hosted by Prime Minister Kishida and Mrs Kishida.
- 7 During our visit to the Republic of Korea, we intend to seek the following calls and undertake the following engagements:
 - Wreath laying at the National War Memorial of Korea;
 - Meet with Korea's Minister of Foreign Affairs, Mr. Cho Tae-yeol;

- Meet with Korea's National Security Adviser Chang Ho-jin;
- Meet with US General Paul LaCamera, Commander of the United Nations Command: and
- Host a reception at the Official Residence for bilateral relationship stakeholders.
- 8 During the bilateral aspects of our visit to Japan, we intend to seek the Koreigh Affairs following calls and undertake the following engagements:
 - Meet with Japan's Minister of Defence Minoru Kihara;

 - Deliver a Foreign Policy Speech with a Pacific Focus.
- If travel is approved, we will depart New Zealand for Seoul on Sunday 14 July 9 and return to New Zealand on Saturday 20 July.

Ministerial Party

- If approved, a Senior Specialist Ministerial Adviser will accompany the 10 Minister and their costs will be charged to Vote Internal Affairs: Members of the Executive - Travel.
- The Minister's Senior Foreign Affairs Adviser and one senior official from the 11 Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade will also accompany. Their costs will be covered by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade.
