# Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Nicola Grigg - September 2024

Portfolio Trade

On 19 August 2024, Cabinet:

- authorised the absence of Hon Nicola Grigg from New Zealand, subject to leave from Parliament being secured, from 19 to 24 September 2024, to travel to Vientiane, Lao PDR to attend the ASEAN Economic Ministers meetings;
- 2 agreed that she be accompanied by one staff member;
- approved the estimated expenditure of up to \$30,706 for the travel expenses of the ministerial party as a charge to Vote Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive);
- 4 **noted** that she will also be accompanied by officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, whose costs will be met by their agency;
- agreed that in her absence Hon Louise Upston act as Minister for Women;
- 6 **noted** that leave from Parliament has been sought.

### Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Nicola Grigg - September 2024

- I seek Cabinet approval to travel to Vientiane, Lao PDR from 19 − 24 September to attend the annual ASEAN Economic Ministers Meetings.
- The Prime Minister has approved the travel in-principle, and House leave has been sought from the Party Whip.

## Purpose of Travel

- The primary purpose of the travel to Lao PDR is to attend, in my capacity as Minister of State for Trade, the annual ASEAN Economic Minister's Meetings, involving members of ASEAN and their dialogue partners.
- New Zealand's attendance at ministerial level will reinforce our commitment to our partnership with ASEAN in line with the government's increased focus on our relationships in Southeast Asia. Ministerial representation, and building relationships face to face, is essential to protect and promote New Zealand's interests and values in the region.
- The visit will highlight the importance of our trade and economic relationship with ASEAN and support progress on our two ASEAN-led regional free trade agreements AANZFTA and RCEP. It will be an important opportunity to demonstrate our commitment to, and help influence, the ASEAN-led regional economic architecture.
- The ASEAN meetings that I will attend are the ASEAN Closer Economic Relations Partners (Australia and New Zealand) Consultation, East Asia Summit (EAS) Economic Ministers Meeting and the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership Ministers Meeting.
- 7 Will also attend the AANZFTA Regional Business Roundtable and conduct bilateral meetings with my Ministerial counterparts relating to the ASEAN Economic Ministers' meetings and my trade delegations.

- 8 I will be accompanied by my Ministerial Advisor.
- 9 I will also be accompanied by officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, whose travel costs will be met by departmental budgets.
