Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Simon Watts - September/October 2024

Portfolio Climate Change

On 9 September 2024, Cabinet:

- authorised the absence of Hon Simon Watts from New Zealand, from 30 September to 2 October 2024, to travel to Nadi, Fiji to attend the Pacific Island Countries Climate Change Ministerial Talanoa and hold bilateral meetings;
- agreed that he be accompanied by one member of staff;
- approved the estimated expenditure of up to \$13,831 for the travel expenses of the Ministerial party as a charge to Vote Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive Travel);
- 4 **noted** that he will be accompanied by officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, whose travel costs will be met by the Ministry;
- 5 **agreed** that in his absence:
 - 5.1 Hon Nicola Willis act as Minister of Climate Change;
 - 5.2 Hon Andrew Bayly act as Minister of Revenue;
- 6 **noted** that the House is not sitting during his absence.

Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Simon Watts - 30 September - 2 October 2024

- I seek Cabinet approval to travel to Nadi, Fiji from 30 September to 2 October to attend the Pacific Island Countries Climate Change Ministerial Talanoa with Australia and New Zealand.
- The Prime Minister has approved the travel in-principle.

Purpose of Travel

- The Climate Change Ministerial Talanoa is convened by the Secretariat of the Pacific Regional Environment Programme (SPREP) and the Pacific Islands Forum Secretariat (PIFS), with funding support from Australia.
- The Talanoa will occur on Tuesday the 1st of October, preceded by an official Ministerial reception co-hosted by Australia and SPREP on 30 September.
- My participation in the Talanoa will reinforce New Zealand's commitment to supporting climate resilience in the Pacific, global climate action, and an effective outcome at COP29.
- It will deliver on the commitment made with my Australian counterpart, at the recent 2+2 Climate and Finance Dialogue, to work together with the Pacific to address climate change.
- My participation in the Talanoa will demonstrate New Zealand's strong support for Australia's bid to co-host COP31, in partnership with the Pacific, in 2026. A 'Pacific COP' in Australia would be a significant opportunity to increase representation and participation for our region and deliver on Pacific priorities.
- There is broad consensus of the value of increased regional engagement at a political level on climate change issues ahead of annual UN climate talks. The Talanoa also presents an opportunity to deepen relationships with my counterparts in the Pacific.
- 9 During my visit to Nadi, Fiji, I will undertake the following engagements:
 - 9.1 Represent New Zealand at the Climate Change Ministerial Talanoa;
 - 9.2 Hold bilateral meetings with Ministerial counterparts;
 - 9.3 Host a dinner for Ministerial counterparts;

9.4 Subject to scheduling, undertake a trip to one of Fiji's emergency operations centres to further understanding of extreme weather event readiness.
