Thank you for your email of 9 February 2025 to Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) in which you requested information under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA). On 18 February 2025, the following part of your request was transferred from DPMC to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (the Ministry) for response:

I would like confirmation regarding how much the Crown has paid (in the past 5, by year) towards overseas travel (single and return tickets) for Cook Islands (CI)'s government staff to China (including to Hong Kong or via third-party country), including travel by -

- the CI Prime Minister's office;
- CI prime minister's family;
- other CI government officials.

And accommodation and other costs associated with travel.

Please also confirm NZ government budgets for CI's ministry of foreign affairs for the same period and future.

We can confirm that the Ministry has not paid for any overseas travel for Cook Islands Government Minsters or officials to China in the period 8 February 2020 to 18 February 2025.

In the period 18 February 2020 to 18 February 2025, the Ministry, on behalf of the New Zealand Government, has not provided a budget to the Cook Islands Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Immigration. Accordingly, this part of your request is refused under section 18(e) of the OIA as the information you requested does not exist.
