Report on Overseas Travel: Hon Todd McClay - October-November 2024

I recommend that Cabinet note this report on my travel to Doha, Qatar from 30 October to 1 November.

### Report

- The primary purpose of this travel was to announce the conclusion of the New Zealand-GCC trade agreement during the Gulf Cooperation Council's Trade Minister's Meeting being hosted by current Chair Qatar.
- Qatar's Minister of Commerce and Industry, His Excellency Sheikh
  Mohammed Bin Hamad Bin Qassim Al-Abdullah Al-Thani opened the session
  by underlining the significance of the FTA's conclusion to all negotiating
  parties. I was then invited to make a statement before signing the FTA
  conclusion memorandum along with the GCC's Secretary-General His
  Excellency Jasem Mohamed AlBudaiwi.
- The GCC Secretary-General emphasised that the FTA reflected a shared commitment to further strengthen and enhancing the longstanding relationship between New Zealand and the GCC. He expressed optimism that, once implemented, the FTA would bolster trade and economic cooperation, attract greater investment, and expand collaboration in areas of mutual interest.
- New Zealand joins an exclusive club as the GCC has only concluded FTAs with three other entities Singapore, EFTA, and Korea. The GCC region is poised for significant economic growth, with GDP projected to reach US\$3 trillion by 2030 and US\$6 trillion by 2050. New Zealand now has the formal trade architecture in place to really take advantage of these economic opportunities.
