- 1 I seek Cabinet approval to travel to the United Arab Emirates ^{s6(a), s9(2)(j)} from 10 January to 17 January 2025, in my capacity as Minister for Trade.
- The Chief of Staff has approved the travel in-principle, and leave has been approved by the Party Whip.

Purpose of Travel

- The primary purpose of this visit is to sign the UAE-New Zealand Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) and UAE-New Zealand Bilateral Investment Treaty (BIT). I will accompany the Prime Minister in these engagements, demonstrating the value New Zealand places on the bilateral relationship with our closest partner in the Middle East region through meetings with the UAE President and other leaders.
- I intend to arrive ahead of the Prime Minister on 10 January 2025 to undertake a short bilateral programme to prepare for the signing, including with my trade counterpart H.E. Dr Thani Bin Ahmed Al Zeyoudi.
- There will also be opportunities to use the visit to leverage New Zealand's trade and economic relations with the Middle East's most dynamic and internationalised economy, in particular to attract foreign direct investment (FDI) including into New Zealand's renewable energy and infrastructure sectors.
