Timeline to completion

Public engagement

Government continues to discuss the outcomes with New Zealanders, online, in writing, and face-to-face

Agreement in Principle reached

The Agreement in Principle confirms the parameters of the agreement and sets out the terms on which the FTA text will be concluded

Negotiations conclude and treaty text finalised

Negotiators finalise the FTA text in accordance with the principles and terms set out in the AIP document

National interest analysis

Officials produce a report sharing what is in the FTA and how it affects New Zealanders

Domestic process for ratification

Both countries begin their legal processes to give effect to the FTA

Signing

Ministers from both countries sign the FTA

Cabinet review

Cabinet reviews the final text and decides if New Zealand will sign the FTA

Select committee examines

The Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade Select Committee examines the FTA and NIA and reports on its views and effects

Implementing legislation

Parliament considers legislation required to implement the FTA

Ratification

New Zealand is ready for the Free Trade Agreement to enter into force
